

CARING FOR YOUR EARTHSTONE SURFACE

EVERYDAY CLEANING

For daily cleaning, simply wipe over your Earthstone Surface with a sponge and warm water. Never use scourers, steel wool or abrasive cleansers on your Surface.

For stubborn stains, dilute a small amount of bleach and apply to the affected area ensuring you wipe off with water directly after use.

SCRATCH RESISTANT

Earthstone is scratch resistant although we recommend that you do not chop on, or gouge the surface with sharp implements. Cutting boards should be used when cutting on any polished surfaces.

STAIN RESISTANT

Earthstone is stain resistant to most common household food and liquid products. It is recommended not to leave food and liquid spills for extended periods. Chemicals such as solvents, acetone, acid or alkaline product can cause damage.

Coffee, tea, lemon juice and red wine may cause staining if left for long periods of time so we recommend cleaning any spills quickly with earm water and a cloth.

HEAT RESISTANT

Earthstone is heat resistant to 300°F/148°C. We recommend allowing your pots to cool before placing them on the Surface and the use of trivets under hot articles is recommended.

Extreme heat may cause damage.

CARE OF PERLA PRODUCTS

Earthstone's specific Perla products feature a raw natural mother of pearl shell. This natural shell is made of calcium carbonate, which by its very nature is softer than the granite and quartz material that makes up the rest of the slab.

Some degradation of the shell is expected over time and is quite normal, and this will be more noticeable in high traffic areas that receive increased exposure to moisture and cleaning.

Care should be taken to avoid harsh cleaners and acids, such as lemon juice and vinegar as this will lead to an increase in the degradation of the shell content.
